L.A. Beer Week Kickoff Festival


The Maltose Falcons providing some much need hydration to the festgoers at the LA Beer Week Kickoff Festival.


June Shop Brew

Everyone Participates, from Start to Finish

The brew session will use the Club's 40 gallon all grain system at the homebrew shop. There are 5 spots on this brew crew, including the crew leader(s), and the Falcon's Shares, which will be poured at the 45h annivsary ball. All Brew Crew members will participate in all aspects of the brewing process from measuring and crushing the grain to clean up and fermentation. Yeast will be provided, unless otherwise announced. We need one crew member to step forward to ferment the Falcon's Share at home!

Economical & Educational

Unless otherwise announced, yeast will be provided for participants, but you may also choose to use your own yeast. Each participant will pitch in for the cost of ingredients (usually \$10-\$15 cash), and take 5 gallons of wort to ferment at home. So it's very economical and a great opportunity to get some hands-on brewing experience on a larger, more sophisticated brewing system than most homebrewers have access to, learn new recipes, and, of course, a chance to hang out with your fellow Falcons and share brews and snacks. Bring a carboy, bucket or keg for your wort, or buy one in the shop.

You must be a dues-paid Maltose Falcons member in order to join the brew crew.

However, anyone, non-members included, is welcome to observe and learn the all-grain brewing process, hang out and chat with the Crew. Beer and snacks to share are always welcome.
